



## Call for Post-doctoral fellowships

The Labex Memolife is launching the present call to offer funding for post-doctoral fellows who are working in or wish to join one of Memolife participating teams.

**Within a flexible format, this call aims to:**

- 1/ attract young talented scientists of any nationality;
- 2/ allow Memolife participating teams to increase their research potential;

MemoLife will fund post-doctoral fellows for a period of 6 to 12 months maximum, to participate in one of its team's research projects, as defined within the Labex context. **Only one application from each participating team will be considered within this Call.**

The proposed annual salary, based on experience (including previous post-doc), will range between 25.000 and 30.000 €. No prolongation of this initial funding will be possible.

Applications should include:

- Letter of motivation (1 page) ;
- Complete CV with a list of publications (2 pages);
- Summary of previous accomplishments and proposed research project (5 pages max);
- Letter of support from the host team leader, indicating how the proposed project is relevant to Memolife strategic priorities;
- A maximum of two letters of reference from personalities who can attest the applicant's credentials;
- A summary form including:
  - Last name
  - First name
  - Date of birth
  - Nationality
  - Place and date of PhD earning
  - Current Status (Position/Name of supervisor/Host laboratory/University)
  - Name of the Memolife host team leader
  - Expected start/end date of funding

Evaluations procedures:

Applications will be evaluated by members of the Labex Steering Committee

Selection criteria :

Applications will be evaluated based on the quality of the applicant's curriculum and the thesis results (must be defended prior to september 30th, 2020, with the defense date set at the time of the application) and of a first post-doctoral experience, if applicable, as well as the quality of the project and its relevance to the Memolife scientific context.
